An important announcement regarding UNSW Gateway

Recently we notified St Clare's High School that under the revised eligibility criteria for UNSW Gateway, students from St Clare's High School would no longer be eligible for this admission pathway from 2021 onward.

Rest assured though, that current Year 12 students from St Clare's High School remain eligible to participate in the Gateway Admissions Pathway in 2020 and we look forward to welcoming them into the program. Applicants are also eligible for priority consideration for available equity scholarships, including accommodation scholarships.

Introducing the UNSW Gateway Winter Program

In the wake of the current COVID-19 crisis, UNSW has reimagined its Gateway Program to become an innovative and exciting new Admission Pathway specifically for students from UNSW Gateway partner schools.

We know that many students face significant barriers on the pathway from school to university, and the current crisis has made those obstacles even more challenging.

The Gateway Admission Pathway and Program supports students from Gateway partner schools to navigate a clear pathway to university, providing eligible students with an early conditional offer to UNSW. An early conditional offer considers applicants on the basis not only of their ATAR, but on the many other attributes that students bring to their studies at school and university.

In 2020, Year 12 students from St Clare's High School are eligible to participate in the Gateway Admission Pathway and Program.

It is important to note that the Gateway Admission Pathway prioritises students with a residential address in the lowest 25% of areas, as ranked by the [SEIFA index](#).

The Gateway Winter Program is a 100% digital HSC revision and preparation program that students from Gateway schools can access for free in the July school holidays. The Gateway Winter Program provides comprehensive study support from subject matter experts, current UNSW students, tutors and mentors. Participants in the Gateway Winter Program will also receive guidance in applying for an early conditional offer to UNSW.
