# Eligibility

The following criteria apply to Tuckwell Scholarship applicants for undergraduate study at ANU commencing in 2021.

#### 2020 Eligibility Criteria

To apply for a Tuckwell Scholarship for study at ANU commencing in 2021, applicants must:

- 1. be eligible to apply to study at ANU in 2021 via the <u>ANU Direct Application</u> system.
- 2. commence and complete Year 12 full-time in 2020, at a school located in Australia.
- 3. be 17, 18 or 19 years old on 1 March 2021 (born on or between 2 March 2001 and 1 March 2004).
- 4. be an Australian citizen, Australian Permanent Resident or the holder of an Australian humanitarian visa, and be in possession of the relevant Birth Certificate, Citizenship Certificate or Visa by 25 May 2020.
- 5. be predicted by their school to achieve an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) of 95 or higher. Applicants who are eligible for consideration under the <a href="Educational Access Scheme">Educational Access Scheme</a> (EAS) may apply for a Tuckwell Scholarship if they are predicted by their school to achieve an ATAR of 90 or higher.
- 6. have undertaken:
  - at least one high school English course/unit in at least one semester during Year 11 or Year 12; and
  - at least one high school Maths course/unit in at least one semester during Year 11 or Year 12.

#### Candidacy Requirements

- Candidates must submit an ANU Direct Application by 25 May 2020.
- Scholars must commence an undergraduate program at ANU in Semester 1, 2021.
- Scholars must adhere to the <u>Tuckwell Scholarship Conditions of Award</u>, as amended from time to time, for the full duration of their Scholarship.
