

## Preparation Materials

### **Are there any practice questions or preparation materials available?**

Yes, there are extensive resources available on the [Practice Tests page](#) which are available to everyone, regardless of whether you have registered or booked your test yet. These have been developed so that you have everything you need to support your preparation, including a Question Tutorial, a Question Bank with over 1000 free example questions and 3 free fully timed Practice Tests which mimic the live test environment.

### **Do I have to pay for these preparation materials?**

No, all resources contained on the UCAT ANZ website are *FREE*. Candidates should be aware that whilst there are many commercial companies publishing books and offering coaching for the test, we do not work with any of these companies or endorse the use of their materials.

### **What is the Scratch Pad feature in the Practice Tests?**

The Scratch Pad is an electronic version of the laminated note book provided at the test centre used for working or making notes. UCAT ANZ candidates DO NOT need to practise using the scratch pad feature as it is not included in the UCAT ANZ test. Candidates are provided a laminated note book and marker pen at the test centre.

### **The preparation materials on the website refer to the UCAT, not the UCAT ANZ – is this a different test?**

Although introduced to Australia and New Zealand in 2019, the UCAT has been used for over 12 years in the UK (previously under the test name UKCAT). The preparation materials provided on our website represent the content of the UCAT ANZ test and should be used to familiarise yourself with the test format and to prepare for the test.

### **I've been told I should pay for a coaching course in order to do well in the UCAT, is this true?**

No. Whilst there are many commercial companies offering coaching for the UCAT, we do not work with any of these companies or endorse the use of their materials. These courses can cost candidates a great deal of money and we would advise you to be sceptical about their claims. Commercial organisations are not affiliated with UCAT. They may be using items that are not necessarily of the standard you will encounter in the UCAT and this may distort your performance whilst practising.
